GOOD NEIGHBOR POLICY

To keep your Large Vehicle Refuge Permit, you must follow the City's Good Neighbor Policy. These rules help ensure safety, clean streets, and positive relationships with neighbors.

GOOD NEIGHBOR POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

- **Permit Display:** Place the sticker on the left rear bumper so it's always visible.
- **Clean Streets:** Keep sidewalks clear, belongings inside the vehicle, and dispose of waste only at RV dump stations
- **Debris Removal**: Allow Public Works staff to clear debris around your vehicle.
- Fire Safety: No open flames on city streets, sidewalks, or public spaces.
- Utilities: Do not connect to city or private utilities (fire hydrants, PG&E, etc.).
- **Noise:** Keep noise levels low to respect nearby residents.

ENFORCEMENT OF THE GOOD NEIGHBOR POLICY

The City uses a progressive enforcement approach to support compliance with the policy:

- 1st & 2nd violation: Courtesy notices will be issued
- 3rd violation: Final notice before permit revocation
- **Revoked permits:** Vehicle becomes subject to the two-hour parking limit and may be cited or towed
- Immediate towing: May occur for serious life and safety risks
